PURPOSE

The purpose of this work session is to review draft recommendations, isolate critical corridors for more detailed conversation, and to reconcile any potential disconnects between study recommendations and local vision. The expectation is to gain general endorsement of cross-section recommendations and reduce the possibility of unknown conflicts prior to study finalization.

FORMAT

In an effort to reduce the overall length of the work session, the meetings will be organized by geography. In total the expectation is that 3 separate work sessions will be performed and will be attended by RPO, MPO, and local jurisdiction representatives.

OBJECTIVES

- ◆ Introduce critical corridor identification process.
 - ◆ Reference the Universe of Projects and V/C mapping
 - ◆ Special corridors (gateways, locations mentioned in other plans or studies, etc.)
 - ◆ Corridors with recent/current development activity
 - ◆ Perceived near and mid-term needs
- ◆ Validate selection of critical corridors.
- ◆ Review the process for draft cross-section assignment.
 - ◆ Context + Street Type + Capacity = Initial Draft Recommendation
 - ◆ Context Summary (using the 5 Community Types from the scenario planning process)
 - ◆ Street Types Consistent with CAMPO Cross-Sections
 - ◆ Capacity Needs determined through travel modeling
 - ◆ Bike and Ped influenced by mode-specific recommendations and context
- ◆ Discuss any potential disconnects between initial draft recommendations and local vision.
